



Cost of raw materials: cotton

As the graph highlights, the cost of cotton in one year increased by 68%, from 88 cents/pound to 144 cents/pound.




Cost of energy: electricity




Cost of energy: gas

Furthermore we can also find our Ciuta and Elastico projects.



















Tinti Filo collects the best cottons designed according to the latest trends.



In conclusion to the book the renowned shuttle sweatshirt, perfect for relaxing or working from home.






